

The time has come to test your skills, passion, and potential as we begin the search for Uganda's finest debaters to represent us on the global stage in 2025. After an incredible year for Uganda's debate teams in 2024, we are back stronger and more determined to build a dominant and competitive Ugandan debate circuit for the future. The trials will be conducted online over two days this weekend, the 4th and 5th of January 2025, on Discord. We have hired a team of great and highly experienced judges who will evaluate you over a 2 day period.

FORMAT & TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE.


Duration: The tournament will take place over two days. **Rounds:** There will be 7 preliminary rounds followed by a final round between the top 2 ranking teams.

Round Structure:

R1 (First Round) will be randomly paired. Rounds 2-7 will be power paired.

Please note that all rounds will be impromptu rounds. There will be no prepared motions.

Prep time for each round will be 30 minutes.






IMPORTANT GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

Eligibility: All debaters that have received an invitation and completed payment are welcome to participate and compete to be in any of the National Teams. However, to be eligible for Team A(WSDC Panama team), participants must be born after August 3rd, 2005. This is a very strict rule as all WSDC participants must be 19 years and below by the end of the tournament. Those who are above this age are however not limited to being on the Cranes B or C team.

All participants must be registered and have made full payment prior to the tournament to ensure participation.

Time Efficiency: We are committed to running a highly efficient tournament. Teams will be dropped if they are late. We expect timely preparation and attendance for each round.










IMPORTANT GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

Advancement to Physical Tryouts:
A number of participants will be selected based on performance in this tournament to advance to physical tryouts next weekend, at the discretion of the Chief Adjudicators (CAP) and Debate Institute Africa (DIA).

ADDITIONAL NOTES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Payment and Registration: Participants must ensure their registration and payment are completed in full before the tournament to secure their place.

Late payments or non-payments will disqualify teams from participation.

Use of Discord: Participants will need to join the tournament's Discord server for detailed instructions and debate coordination. This platform will be essential for smooth communication between organizers and debaters.
